

Installation Instructions for Levelers

(PN #48-979050, 48-979052, 48-979051)

- PARKING YOUR RV

- 1. Select a campsite with a flat parking area.
- 2. Position RV in the most level location of the site.

- Position UF LEVELERS

- 1. Determine which wheels must be raised.
- 2. Always leave one wheel on the ground.
- 3. Create a smooth area under the wheels to be raised by removing large stones and debris.
- 4. Stack UF LEVELERS to the required height. (Sample configurations are shown below.)
- 5. Place UF LEVELERS against the wheels to be raised.

- Drive RV Onto UF LEVELERS


- 1. Slowly drive RV onto the top of the stack.
- 2. If the vehicle is still not level, slowly drive RV off of the stack and remove or add UF LEVELERS to achieve a level position.
- 3. Slowly dive RV back onto the stack.
- 4. Set the parking brake and turn off the engine.
- Leaving Your Campsite
- 1. Slowly drive RV off of the stack of UF LEVELERS.
- 2. Set the parking brake and turn off the engine.
- 3. Retrieve the UF LEVELERS and return them to the nylon storage bag.
- 4. Store the complete UF LEVELERS kit in a secure storage compartment in RV for the next use.

SAFETY WARNING

- 1. DO NOT POSITION UF LEVELERS WHILE THE ENGINE IS RUNNING OR THE VEHICLE IS IN MOTION.
- 2. ENSURE THAT ALL PEOPLE ARE STANDING CLEAR OF THE VEHICLE PRIOR TO MOVING IT ONTO THE STACK OF UF LEVELERS
- 3. NEVER CRAWL UNDER THE VEHICLE WHEN UF LEVELERS ARE IN USE.
- 4. MAXIMUM STACK HEIGHT IS NOT TO EXCEED 5"

SAMPLES AND HELPFUL HINTS

UF LEVELERS can be stacked in several configurations to achieve the required lift.



- When using UF LEVELERS under hydraulic jack or fifth-wheel support jacks, always stack at them least 2 blocks high.
- Do not use blocks upside down.
